students to participate in their learning and apply the skills and knowledge they are acquiring in a variety of authentic ways.

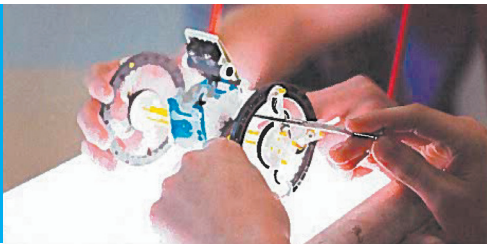

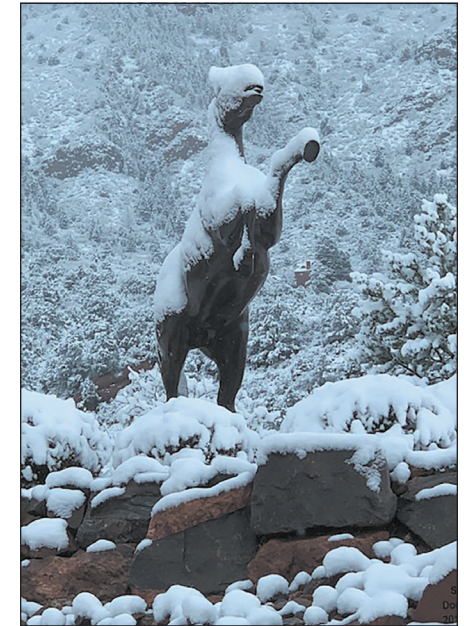
