MeetingAttendees: Ron Hamilton, Debie Bennett, Mary Ann Corey, Serena Vogel, Coralyn Gauvin

Spirit Wear:

- Tayco is more expensive. Debie mentioned that she likes the attention to detail they give. Three colors and hoodies are expensive. Don has good turn around time. He wants us to find our own art and he is unwilling to lower his prices.  
The other company we are considering is interested in beating Tayco's prices. Don's 2 color is \$7 and Colorado Custom Printing will do 3 colors for \$6.  
Tie dye is more expensive. All graphics must be approved by the district to reconsider his pricing.
- Homecoming week begins 9/17/18. We discussed having three order forms at different events for Homecoming pre-orders. Debie will create an order form. We will do a first order with Colorado Custom, if Cameron Jones has the artwork or if he can create what we need. We need a 7 day turn around.  
We will order 100 t-shirts and use that money to purchase the hoodies. Everything needs to be appropriate for middle school. We will have small/medium/large shirts as inventory. People can special order other sizes for a few more dollars. Sela will take this project on from here.
- Ron is still working on a financial report...he will get it to us after July 1. \$4006 is from the book sale last school year.

Media Center:

- The work will begin the week of July 23. All materials purchased for this project must be approved through the District 14 finance office. Alain Navaratne has purchased the letters, cans and rewired and will mount/install for \$250. He needs to be reimbursed for drop cloths, stretchers and artwork. "Be you" in neon lights- purchased from Justin Timberlake's failed restaurants. Ron said he can get some petty cash after July 15.
- We will need to purchase other drop cloths and stretchers. Alain will show us how to stretch them for student artwork.
- The alcoves above the little room will need to be measured to make sure the letters will fit. Mary Ann will look for accent chairs and stools. Debie is willing to purchase things to donate to this project. Ron will send an article to us about flexible seating.

#### Concessions:

- We need a committee to own this to help make sure we have a balance of candy/sweets and healthier options.  
Ron can put a schedule together/sign up for shifts based on the current schedule of games. This is a consistent money maker even though it is not a lot. Baked goods are always welcome. Sela may be willing to take this on as well.

#### Teacher Grants:

- We need a steady stream of income to fund the teacher grant program. Ron will invite one of the PAC officers or team members to address staff on 1/21. This will be a very short presentation to talk about the mini-grant.

#### PAC Meetings:

- We are considering moving the PAC meetings to the 2nd Wednesday of each month. Right now, we do not have a plan for food for the meetings. We discussed catering from various restaurants. We also would like to do some community building activities and have the subcommittees submit their notes a week before each meeting.

#### Upper Activity Field:

- Ed Longfield will look for funding for the upper activity area. He likes the idea of the brick fundraiser. We will try to get this ready for the back to school night. \$35 entry point, \$50 and \$100 for larger bricks as possible prices.
- Ron has been talking with American Furniture Warehouse about fundraising ideas, but may need to defer to Russ Vogel on this.

#### Social:

- We talked about providing time for socialization for parents. The idea would be to provide a place for them to chat about school related things, issues with their children, conversations to build community...once a month maybe.

#### Other Fundraising

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We discussed creating a Fun Run for the fall...Iron Mustang...as a fundraiser similar to the MSES fun run.
